### JOINT WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT

#### UNDER, THROUGH, AND OVER GLASS

- Nancy Rotenberg's Secrets Revealed! (Well, Not Quite)

March 15 or March 31 (you choose!).

In January, Nancy Rotenberg delivered a joint presentation to both clubs and presented some of her extraordinary images. Some of these images involve novel ways of interposing glass to create abstract and ethereal designs.

Stuart Lynn has participated in three Rotenberg workshops and has learned the details of some of the techniques she uses to create these magical works. He has also acquired some of the paraphernalia.

He will conduct a workshop to be repeated the morning (9am – noon) and afternoon (1pm – 4pm) of Thursday, March 15 and Saturday, March 31 (that is, four times in all). You bring your camera, film, tripod, and lens(es). The rest will be provided.

Although a macro lens is ideal for this kind of work (bring one if you have one), do not be put off if you do not have a macro lens or a fancy camera. You will have fun regardless and find new ways to shoot interesting images.

The charge for the workshop will be \$8 per session to cover the costs of consumables. This may be an overestimate depending on the number of attendees: any overage will be split between the clubs proportional to the number of member attendees.

There will be a limit of 12 members to each workshop session. You are welcome to sign up for more than one session (to get more glass time!), but preference will be given to ensuring that at least 24 members from Sun City and 24 members from Desert get at least one shot!

The workshops will be held in the Oasis/Canyon rooms of the Sun City Sunset View Club House. Details will be provided to participants.
